- Vendors MUST check in with the Vendor Check-in table upon arrival (located at the northwest corner of the show field).
- ON SHOW DAY: Saturday no trucks/trailers are allowed on the field. Golf cart transport will be available to carry merchandise and materials to booth. Due to show cars entering the field inventory can be brought to your booth after 8:30a.

Additional Requirements:

- Vendors to remain in place until the show cars have exited the field. The event is open to the public from **10:00a to 4:00p.**
- No water, electric power, or vehicle parking is available at the booth areas unless there is prior agreement.
- No food or drink items may be sold or offered for no charge at merchandise vendor booths. Food and drink items are sold only by event food and drink concessions.
- Soliciting donations from show attendees is not allowed.
- Vendors will be provided a parking pass. No parking at the booth site unless prior approval granted.
- No animals allowed unless they are service animals.
- The Rotary Club of Tucson, Rotary Club of Tucson Foundation or The Gregory School are not responsible for any damages to, or theft of Vendor's property or equipment.
- No political/religious signs or handouts allowed Rotary International is a non-sectarian and non-partisan organization.
